- **Keywords:** search words people use to find YOU
 - Know your “keywords” – use job postings and other LI profiles as a guide.
 - Don’t overdo it- be honest and accurate, don’t “stuff”!
 - *“More keywords aren't always better”*
 - *Goal: “Members consider your profile relevant to their search” - (LI Help)*
 - Write your profile for PEOPLE, not search engines.

- Perform system administration functions on various operating systems, including Linux, Unix, and networking devices.
